

## Quarterly Report Highlights

### PRODUCTION

Production for the first quarter of the 2007 – 2008 (FY08) was up 17.45% over the same period one year ago. If this rate continues over the course of the fiscal year, we would anticipate that the Lord would enable us to produce over 175,000 pieces of literature!

### MILESTONES

Everyday Publications has seen some exciting developments in the past few years with the advent of digital printing. Our two Sharp digital presses have both passed the 5,000,000 impressions mark and are still going strong.



### DISTRIBUTION

Distribution for the first quarter of the 2007 – 2008 (FY08) was up 200.83% over the same period one year ago. This equates to an annual distribution of just over 105,000. When we consider the books currently patiently waiting in the container destined for the D. R. Congo (now almost two-thirds full!) and our practice of printing on demand rather than printing for inventory, it would appear that we will be shipping over 175,000 pieces of literature this year. However, we must never forget that numbers are only numbers while God is always God. This is His ministry and we seek to produce and ship as many pieces of literature as He enables. We rejoice to be His servants in this part of His vineyard and rejoice in the fulfillment of His purposes!

### FINANCES

We praise the Lord for His faithfulness and for the generosity of His dear people who share with us the burden of sending books without charge to commended missionaries and national workers in less favored areas of the world. We are pleased to report that all bills were paid at the end of the calendar year, 2007, with sufficient funds on hand to carry on the work into the New Year.
