### BASIC BELIEFS OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH English/Chinese Diglot (bilingual publication)



## IN THE WORDS OF DR. HARLOW

### Joy Ahead! (But why wait?)

The eighteenth century poet, Gerhard Tersteegen, sang:  
*He and I in that bright glory,  
One deep joy shall share;  
Mine to be forever with Him,  
His that I am there!*


Beautiful! The very thought of being forever in His very presence, wherein is the "fulness of joy" (Ps. 16:11). What do we know about that joy?

In a coming Day, God will "rejoice over His people with joy" (Zeph. 3:17). In Hebrew, intensity is achieved by repetition: "...rejoice...with joy". God's Son will rejoice in His works of creation and redemption (Ps. 104:31). And He will rejoice in His Bride "with gladness" (Song of Sol. 3:11). Yes, Heaven will be a place of great joy!

But why wait to experience that joy? Believers can have a taste of that joy today. Is that *really* possible in this world plagued by sin and sorrow, this vale of tears? God says it is. He writes that we are to rejoice *always* (1 Thes. 5:16), even in our troubles (Lk. 6:23). But how do we experience this kind of joy here and now? It comes from *above* as the Lord shares His joy with those who obey His Word (Jn. 15:11). It comes from the Spirit of God *within*: As we yield to His control in our lives, we bear that delightful fruit of joy (Gal. 5:22). That joy comes from *around us* as we see sinners get saved (Lk. 15:6, 9). And it can be found in the knowledge that our names are written in heaven (Lk. 10:20)!

Is your joy running a little low? The best place to start looking is the very place where the prophet found true joy:

*"Your words were found, and I ate them,  
And Your word was to me the JOY and  
REJOICING of my heart..." (Jer. 15:16).*


## My Bibles (Pt. I) *Treasures Beyond Measure*

This year is a very personal year of jubilee for me. It was 50 years ago that I received my very first Bible my Sunday School class given to me by my faithful teacher. I carried that Bible with me to Sunday School, Daily Vacation Bible School, Good News Clubs, and camp. This was the Bible that I

learned to read, that I memorized verses from, that I was taught from and it was this Bible that introduced me to its Author.
