
FROM OUR CHERISHED READERS






IN THE HEART OF A PEARL (Alma Turnbull)

GOD IN US: THE PERSON & WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (Wm. Yuille)



Due to the fact that Everyday Publications Inc. regularly sends 80% - 85% of our books to assembly-commended missionaries and national workers at no charge, it is hard to refer to any title as a “best seller”. But if you were to ask which title is the “most distributed” of all the E.P.I. books, the answer is obvious. *Food for New Believers* (formerly known as *12 Bottles of Milk for New Believers*) is the most widely distributed E.P.I. title with more than 30,000 copies sent out in the last 10 years

alone! *Food for New Believers* is a concise collection of 12 lessons that explains to a new believer the basic facts about their new-found faith such as faith, assurance of salvation, the two natures, the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, believer’s baptism, sanctification, prayer, the church, the priesthood of the believer, Christian service, the Lord’s return, and the believer’s reward.

Healthy Perspective

Thank you to all who have rejoiced with us regarding the ways the Lord has blessed and miraculously worked through the ministry of Everyday Publications during the last 50 years. Over 60 years ago, shortly after I first

went to Congo as a green missionary, I had an experience that I have never forgotten. An African believer showed me a scrap of paper which was very precious to him. It was a piece of a page that someone had torn out of a Gospel of John, crumpled up and dirty. And I thought then—and many times since then—if that little portion of God's Word was such a blessing to him, what a tremendous blessing the entire Gospel or other book would be...

E.P.I. will soon have distributed four million books—to 4 million people in North, Central, and South America, Asia, Africa, and Europe, to people in many different circumstances, saved and lost, educated or not, rich and poor, free or in prison, speaking English, Spanish, Portuguese, French, or Swahili, all needing to be touched by the Word of God. Just think of the potential, and praise the Lord and rejoice!

But we must be on guard! A magazine I read recently pointed out that, "Every reason we have to celebrate must also come with a warning against over confidence".
