### **April 2011**

- **Mon. 4** Praise the Lord for Grace Spence and her diligent work in the shipping department here at EPI and also for her willingness to do the cleaning of the office. Pray for her safety both in her work and on the highway each day.
- **Tues. 5** From Gertrud: "There is no known cure for Raynaud's disease which is due, in part, to the prolonged use of a computer keyboard. The painful and even insensitive fingers make typing an increasing challenge for me as I start translating the second section of the **Believers Bible Commentary**."
- **Wed. 6** As the Lord's return continues to draw closer, pray that we may truly realize the "shortness" of time for the lost. Pray that the Lord would reveal how EPI can be even more effective in reaching many more souls.
