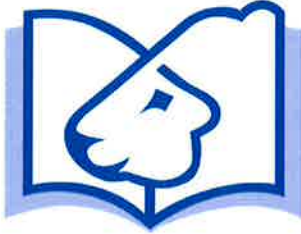

## April 2018
