September - 2012

Sat. 1 *“Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,”* 2 Corinthians 10:5 NKJV. May we all be diligent in keeping our thoughts in line with Christ, remembering that it says in Proverbs 4:23 NCV, *“Be careful what you think, because your thoughts run your life.”*

Sun. 2 Pray for Paul and Dorothy Grieve, missionaries in South Africa at the Murchison Hospital, who are involved with literature work using EPI courses. *“We would appreciate your prayer support re wisdom and discernment for the future. We have a faithful God but we need to be in tune with Him so that we see His path ahead.”*

Mon. 3 Praise the Lord for the happy holiday for the Bondt family on Prince Edward Island in July/August. Pray for much wisdom and strength for Noel and Dwana as they seek to raise their girls “in the Lord”.

Tues. 4 From Mark Beach: *“We were encouraged by a new volunteer this [summer]. Brian Cretney from Brockview Bible Chapel in St. Catharines, ON has been an enthusiastic supporter of EPI for some time and this summer he has made some time available to come and learn how to do typesetting. This will be a great help and is a huge answer to prayer!”*

Wed. 5 Mark reports: *“EPI is working with Eleanor Sims (refocused missionary to Zimbabwe) to print and ship 3 Emmaus correspondence courses that she has updated and revised. We are also working with the believers in Zimbabwe through Eleanor to determine what the need might be for a quantity of EPI books to be shipped along with the Emmaus courses.”* Pray for the Lord’s leading.

Thurs. 6 Pray for Thirza Beach as she leaves September 10 for three months to assist a missionary family in “Special Areas”. Pray for safety in travel, grace in adapting to a new culture, and open doors to share the Gospel.

Fri. 7 Pray that Grace Spence would return to work rested and refreshed on September 10 after her vacation.

Sat. 8 Continue to pray for authors writing books for EPI. Pray that the Holy Spirit would speak through each one and would use these books for His glory.

Sun. 9 From David Rodgers (Chile): *“We appreciate your ministry so much, and hope to be able to travel more this year to promote the books. Please give our greetings and wishes for blessing for all who work there, to make these materials available.”*

Mon. 10 Pray for staff as they do the annual inventory of the warehouse today. Pray that this tedious yet necessary task would be done well for His glory.

Tues. 11 From Gertrud Harlow: *“Pray that the first volume of Wm. MacDonald’s Believers Bible Commentary (NT) in Congo Swahili will soon be printed. Solid Bible teaching is urgently needed to build up the assemblies again after the recent war”* (PED *(Pray Every Day)* May 6).

Wed. 12 Happy 25th Anniversary to Mark and Gail Beach! Praise the Lord for God’s faithfulness through the years and for bringing them to EPI.

Thurs. 13 Pray for Harold and Barb MacDougall as they travel east (Sept. 12 - Oct. 2) for a family wedding in Halifax, NS. Pray for Harold as he speaks at various assemblies and for time to rest and relax with family and friends.

September – 2012

Fri. 14 Praise the Lord for the overall smooth operation of equipment at EPI. Pray for continued safety and minimal breakdowns.

Sat. 15 From Mark: *“The [relatively small] number of French and especially Portuguese books requested tells us that we need to seek the Lord’s mind, method and blessing to make our books more widely known amongst those ministering in those languages.”*

Sun. 16 From Marcia Vanderlaan (Colombia): *“There’s a group of four ladies who meet on Wednesday afternoons, using as a guide the book “Eternal Security” by Dr. Harlow. It’s a joy to see how these women appreciate the truths of Scripture and are growing in the Lord.”*

Mon. 17 Join Sara Townsend in praising the Lord that *Paul’s Letters from Prison, Vol. 2: Colossians and Philemon* in Spanish is in the final stages of preparation for printing, D.V. Pray that all may be completed in good order as final details are dealt with.

Tues. 18 Pray for the Lord’s open door to provide a large order of books to Venezuela. Pray for a positive response to our contact with believers there.

Wed. 19 For the months of May, June, and July the print shop processed 47,804 items: 37,070 were EPI stock and 10,734 were outside jobs. Praise the Lord for the many answers to prayer that this represents.

Thurs. 20 From Alma Turnbull: *“Wisdom, strength for the day, and the big problem of ‘the tyranny of the urgent’ are my daily prayer needs. I’m grateful that EPI is not adding unrealistic deadlines to my typesetting commitments. I hope to have the reformatting of ACTS - The Ongoing Church completed and sent to Eunice (our proofreader) in a few days!”*

Fri. 21 Praise the Lord for the functional facilities that the Lord has provided for EPI here in Port Colborne. Pray for continued protection and freedom from fire, flood, and vandalism.

Tues. 9 Pray for Mark and Gail as they present the work of EPI and host a book table at the US Workers' and Elders' Conference in Kansas City, Kansas today through Thursday.

Tues. 23 Pray for the Lord's wisdom and timing regarding the printing and shipping of the ***Congo Swahili Believers Bible Commentary – Vol. 1.***
