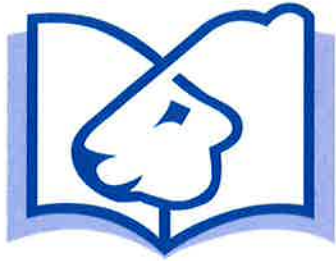

## January 2020

Although her work on earth is now completed, praise the Lord that she *"being dead yet speaketh"* by means of the thousands of copies of books which she typeset over the course of her 35 years with EPI.

**Mon. 27** From Don MacMullen, President of EPI: *"Pray for all the EPI Staff! Thank God for them and all they do!"*

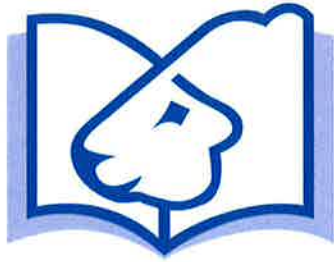
**Tues. 28** Pray that each staff member would be free from unnecessary or distracting concern in their family circle. Pray for faith to trust each one to the Father's care.
