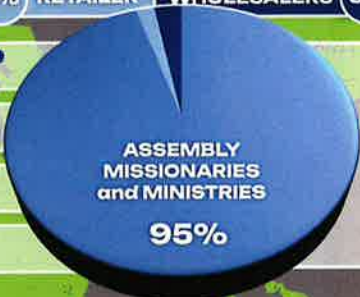

Ninety five percent of all the literature we produce is sent to the mission field or to local assemblies. Thanks to Dr. Harlow and other faithful laborers, EPI has a commentary for every book of the Bible written in simple English (Everyday English). Today, by God's grace, we have over 400 titles in print, and we directly support five languages: English, Congo-Swahili, French, Portuguese, and Spanish. Millions of books have been shipped by Everyday Publications to mission fields around the world. Once there, they are used in **personal evangelism** and **one-on-one discipleship**.

D.R. CONGO TESTIMONY

HONDURAS

We recently shipped boxes of books to assemblies in Honduras.

Here is the testimony of one discipleship leader who uses these materials in Bible teaching classes:

I remember that this material came with brother Roberto..., a missionary brother who helped a lot with the work in Honduras. We thank the brothers in Canada for the gesture, and with this we can help the brothers in Honduras to have more tools for their spiritual development as biblical men of God. We pray for you that the Lord continues to bless you.

After years of rebel activity and conflict that forced the closure of some assemblies, Itendey is slowly coming back to life. The brothers and sisters there gather regularly during the week for prayer, and about 130 gather on Sunday for church service and about 70 for the breaking of the bread. **Praise the Lord!**



A WORD ABOUT THE HEART OF DR. ED & GERTRUD HARLOW

In the will of the Lord, the Harlows applied their experience to start a unique 'Mission' called Everyday Publications whose slogan is, **"Feed My Sheep!"**

How would the Lord use two people to reach millions around the world in multiple languages? The same question is asked today as was asked in 1949 when our most popular book, *What the Bible teaches*, was launched: **"Who will pay for it?"** **Bill MacDonald** answered, **"Never mind, the Lord will provide."** **The Lord still provides all we need*** (p 167).

1. PLAN: A Mission to Missionaries: Our front-line workers are the assembly commended workers and national workers around the world. Today, our authors, editors, and production people write, prepare, and produce **literature to support the assembly Bible teachers in 89 countries**. The assembly workers communicate face to face with those who need the Lord and are being discipled. EPI does everything possible to support them.

2. PURPOSE: The Equipping of Assemblies: "The whole Word for the whole world". It started as a work for the Congo in 1964. Gertrud Harlow had completed the translation of the entire Bible. Ed Harlow said, "I would like to see a commentary in simple English for every book of the Bible." Gertrud replied "Good! As you finish each book, I will translate it into Swahili" (*p 235). This work spread to support assembly workers, correspondence courses for prisons, group Bible studies, and the teaching of biblical doctrines and practices. More than **7 million books have been distributed, with over 400 titles, and have been translated into over 85 languages** (*p 167). What makes our ministry unique is that the worker explains the Scripture teaching one on one, then follows up later.

3. PEOPLE: Giving of themselves to serve the Lord Joyfully: EPI full-time workers are assembly-commended workers, and our part-time workers are mostly volunteers. Assembly workers from around the world, working in a variety of languages,

are happy to apply their skills to write, translate, edit, proofread, teach, and distribute literature. EPI keeps costs at a minimum as 95% of our literature is sent without charge (as the Lord provides) to assembly people in third-world countries (pp 289, 290) where those who cannot afford to purchase Bibles and books treasure the printed word as their most valuable possession.

Ed and Gertrud Harlow set the course, and the Lord has provided through His assemblies **for 60 years.** The **"EPI: Plan, Purpose, and People"** has never changed.

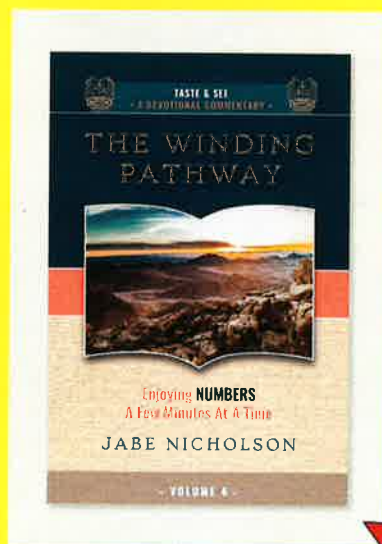

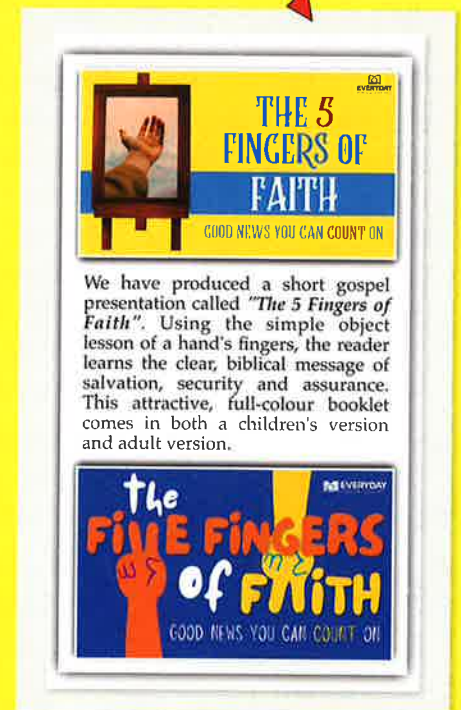

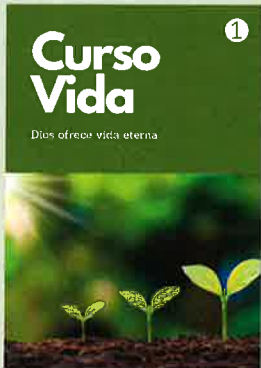
SPANISH DISCIPLESHIP SERIES

Early in 2023, we were given permission from **Ediciones Visión Cristiana (Peru)** to print and distribute their five-book Spanish discipleship series in North America. 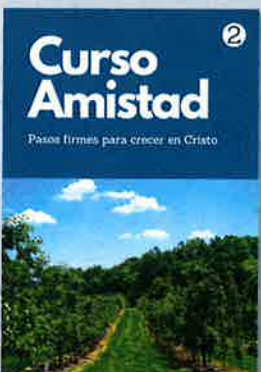


The Life Course, the first course in the program, presents, in an orderly and practical way, the gospel of Jesus Christ, which quenches people's spiritual thirst. The five lessons of the course are applicable to various groups of people:

- * Those who have no faith in Christ
- * Those who believe in God, but want to better understand the Gospel of Christ
- * Those who know Christ and want to be trained to help others know Him

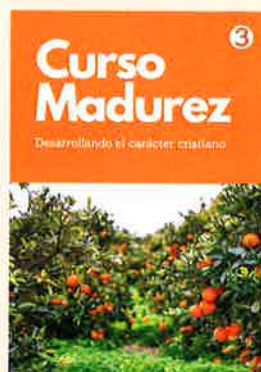

The Friendship Course, the second course of the program, covers topics such

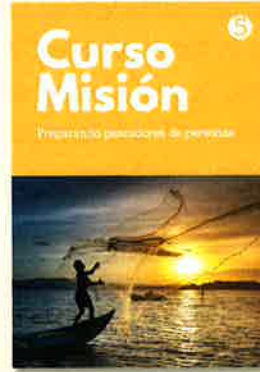
