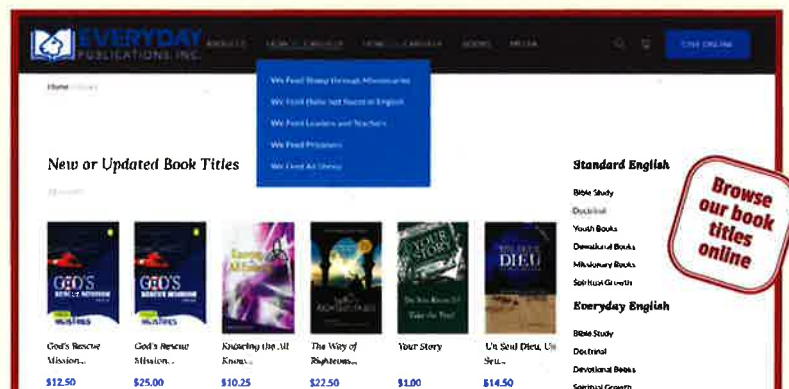
resource for the new believer or young person wanting to get more serious about Bible study.

DR CONGO

Please pray with us for the DRC (Democratic Republic of Congo). The country has had a long and troubled history, and yet the Lord has worked mightily in spite of it all. Most of our current contacts are in the Northeast of the country at the Emmanuel Community in Bunia, near the border of Uganda. Over the past decade, we have shipped many containers of Bibles, hymnbooks, and other Bible study materials to the area, and tens of thousands of books have been distributed to believers and to the unsaved. Many individuals have put their faith and trust in Christ and have come into fellowship in assemblies in the area.

Today they face even greater trials, dealing not only with COVID-19 and Ebola, but attacks by rebel militia. Churches and homes have been burned down, and many people murdered or abducted. We recently received this news from one of the leaders: "We are keeping the big truck here in Bunia. **Bunia town** also was in risk of attack two days ago. We are **surrounded by the rebels** from all sides. We are praying for this situation, for the roads are not safe, [and] many roadblocks are made by the rebels with [the] **purpose of killing people.**"

Praise God that there was a peaceful local election to appoint the **new leaders of Emmanuel Community**, as required by their federal law. Three brothers have been chosen by the believers: Dr Isaac K. Mbabazi was elected as legal representative, Jérémie Kosiambala as 1st Deputy, and Christophe Lotsima as 2nd Deputy. These are godly men who carry a great burden and responsibility for God's people and for the work done there. **Please pray for them.**

We will also be able to cut the cost for other books, especially large quantities going into containers.

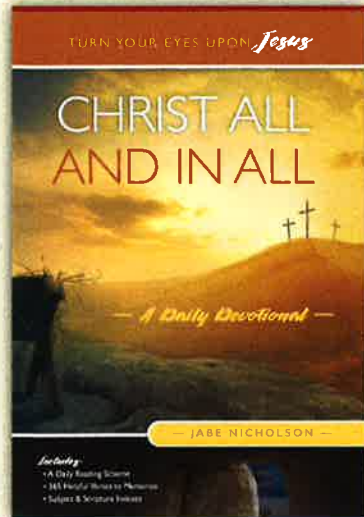

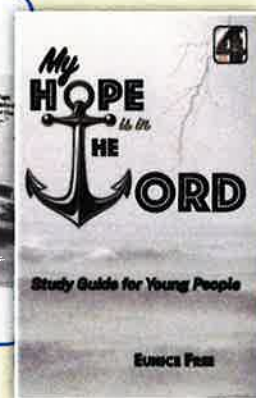
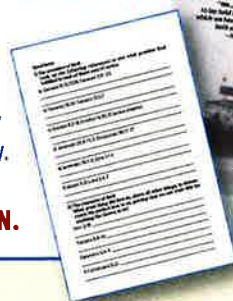


INTRODUCING a STUDY GUIDE for YOUNG PEOPLE:
