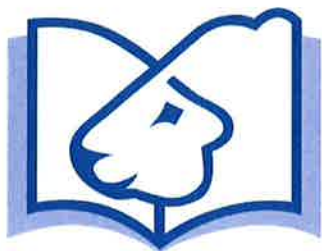

November 2022

Tues. 1 *“Remember the word that I said to you, ‘A servant is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you,”* John 15:20 NKJV. How ready are we for what may be coming soon?

Wed. 2 Thank you for praying for Dwana Bondt (PED (*Pray Every Day*) Sept. 2)!! The Lord has answered wonderfully. All Dwana’s care has been transferred to the top specialists in Hamilton. Good news! She can carry the baby to full term, Dec. 4th, and have surgery in January to remove a “non-aggressive and slow-moving tumor”, a much different diagnosis from August!! Praise the Lord and keep praying!!

Thurs. 3 Praise the Lord that Harold MacDougall and his team were only one book away at time of writing from completion of an order for 108,000 books in French and Congo Swahili begun a little over a year ago!

Fri. 4 From Terry Wilson, Executive Director: *“We are grateful to Harold for his attention to detail and for his ability to manage this project along with the constant stream of other orders as well as inventory replenishment.”*

Sat. 5 Pray that Noel Bondt would have wisdom as he makes arrangements for shipping the EPI Congo container from Port Colborne. It should be ready to leave early this month, D.V.

Sun. 6 Praise the Lord for the safe arrival of all 7 Congo containers, a huge amount of literature for the Lord to use in ministering to many souls!

Mon. 7 There are currently evangelistic outreaches in Northeast DR Congo and in Uganda. Pray that the Lord will use the added resources to bring many to Christ and to encourage and build up the believers.

Tues. 8 An update from Lubumbashi, DR Congo: *“Isabel went to a regional women’s conference recently and took a load of Swahili Bibles to sell. She sold 720 Bibles. So wonderful to see God’s Word in people’s hands...”*

Wed. 9 At time of writing we have access to the new EPI unit through 2 new openings through the concrete walls. Pray for soon completion of the work needed for us to move in.

Thurs. 10 From Brian Cretney: *“Please pray that the Lord would continue to open new avenues for our **Feed My Sheep** videos...powerful and uplifting 2-minute meditations by Rex Trogdon in both English and Swahili.”*

Fri. 11 As we remember those who fought and died to keep us free, may we also remember our Savior Jesus Christ who *“abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,”* 2 Timothy 1:10 NKJV.

Sat. 12 From Terry: *“I received confirmation that the first half of the **BES (Bible Education Services)** translation work in Congo Swahili has been completed and sent to the typesetter in Romania. These calls facilitated the safe arrival of the containers of EPI literature for Uganda and the DR Congo.

Tues. 15 Pray that the transition of equipment into the new space would go smoothly, so that downtime would be minimal.

Wed. 16 Pray that all will be prepared for the postponed Editorial Committee Meeting Nov. 19 and that much will be accomplished for His glory.
